ALL ENTRANTS

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions and is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions. A BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. The up to date BETA list of body protectors can be obtained from www.beta-uk.org.

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage with a 2000 purple label will be permitted. The competitor must inform the secretary at all events.

Medical armbands

Medical armbands are mandatory for any type of cross-country competition. These must be worn on the arm and not on the leg. They should be filled in with the relevant competitor's details. Checks will be carried out in the collecting ring.

All persons attending the event do so at their own risk and BRC/The Sid & Otter Valley RC Committee nor the Land Owners do not accept any liability for any accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, how so ever caused.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate, split or amend classes as required.

Classes may be run in different order to the schedule. It is likely that the 80 will run last.

In the interest of safety, other than due to a technical elimination, any combination failing to complete the show jumping or accumulating in excess of 24 jumping faults will not be allowed to ride the cross country. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The judge's decision is final.

The organisers reserve the right to withhold a proportion of the entry fee if the event is cancelled due to adverse weather.

No entry will be accepted without the full entry fee.

In the event of any delay on the day due to unforeseen circumstances no refund will be made.

There will be no refund of entry fees for withdrawals after 1st June 2018

The course may be walked from 2pm on Saturday 9th June but the course may not be finalised until 9am Sunday 10th June.

STOP WATCHES WILL BE ALLOWED.

The Clubs safeguarding officer's contact details will be displayed in the secretary's office.

Insurance whilst attending BRC events. Non-members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have third party insurance. It is the riders responsibility to ensure that if making an entry they do have the necessary third party insurance in place.

Health and Safety

All who attend the event are responsible for ensuring that they conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Vehicles must be parked so as not to cause obstruction.

Members of the public are requested to keep clear of horse areas and to avoid behaviour which may alarm horses.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.

ANYONE FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES OR HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY WILL BE ASKED TO WITHDRAW. ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
