Winter Dressage Qualifier KSEC: 6th place for our NQ Team of Sophie P (2nd overall), Helen B (7th overall) and Cheryl B.

Arena Eventing Qualifier Bicton: 1st 70cm & 80cm teams and 3rd for the 90cm team seniors (Q) and 1st for the juniors 90cm team (NQ) with many individual wins and placings for both team and non-team riders in all classes. A very successful day out!

Summer SJ Qualifier Bicton: 1st 70cm, 80cm & 90cm teams & a 2nd for the 100cm team (NQ) again with many individual wins and placings for both team and non-team riders in all classes. Another very successful day out!

Horse Trials Qualifier Pontispool: Charlotte Radley 90cm (11th), Hayley Foster 100cm (5th)

Arena Eventing Champs Aston: Sent a 70cm 9th overall



Combined Training Qualifier Stockland Lovell: Novice team 2nd, Open team (3rd) with several individual wins and placings

Summer Dressage Qualifiers Chard: Several placings for members across all classes

SWWRC Champs Hartpury: We had several placings in both the SJ and dressage classes


